



William (Bill) Evaul came to Provincetown in 1970 as a Visual Arts Fellow at the Fine Arts Work Center. While consistently creating paintings and prints, he has served as an Arts Consultant, Gallery and Museum Director, Curator, Art Historian, and writer including Executive Director of the Provincetown Art Association and Museum (1989-90.) Evaul lectures and teaches at many museums, schools and arts organizations nationally. His artwork is held in numerous private collections nation-wide and internationally. Public collections with his work include the Boston Museum of Fine Art, The Library of Congress, the Zimmerli Art Museum at Rutgers University, The Cape Cod Museum of Art, the Provincetown Art Association and Museum, and others.

In 1979, while writing for Print Review magazine, Evaul re-discovered a rare form of woodblock printmaking, which was invented in Provincetown in 1915 and became known as the "Provincetown Print." Now known as the whiteline color woodcut, this technique has gained renewed recognition. Evaul adopted the process and continues to extend its creative spirit by introducing numerous innovations, producing hundreds of carved woodblocks and prints and teaching the technique nationwide. Together with his colleague, Fred Dylla, Ph.D., he is a lead consultant for the Boston Museum of Fine Art and is working on completing a two-volume treatise on the subject of the Provincetown Print or white-line color woodcut.

In addition to his studio work and scholarly writing, William Evaul is the Principal Appraiser at William Harper Appraisers, which produces USPAP certifies Appraisal Reports for Charitable Donation Tax Credit, Estate Probate, Insurance Purposes, and Collection Management.

He is currently working on 'Black Sam' a limited series based on the true tale of the pirate Captain "Black Sam" Bellamy and his love for Maria Hallet the "Witch of Wellfleet".

When he isn't making comics, Craig works as a teaching artist, volunteers with local community arts organizations, and finds ways to use his voice and his art to advocate for issues he's passionate about.



My life and my paintings embody the contradictory dialectic of my existence as a land-owning Black man in America. I have always been pushed to define my work in one way, but I cannot because I am many things at one time, all of which are layered into my paintings.
