HOW ACCESS WORKS

The Access Program supports three core areas:

Cultural Field Trips

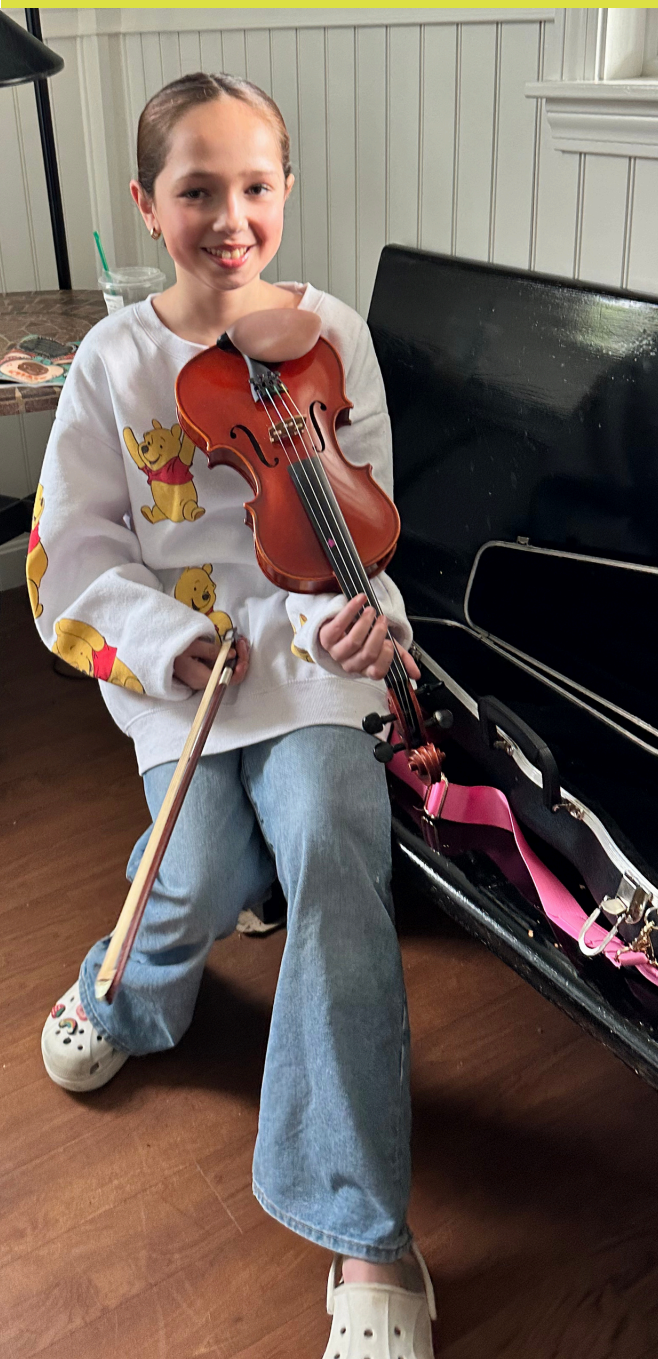
We provide bus stipends and entry fee support for local schools and educators, making it easier to bring students to museums, theaters, and cultural venues. Often, these are first-time experiences for many children.

Youth Arts Scholarships

We fund extracurricular arts programs—from theater and music to dance and painting—for children ages 8–18. Scholarships are distributed through trusted partners who work directly with families in need.

Access Grants to Artists & Organizations

We fund artists and cultural organizations already delivering inclusive and equity-centered programming. These grants help expand access to the arts for youth and families who are traditionally underserved.
